The Balm of Revelation (Recap) Job 33:21-25, Job 2:7

You need an understanding of your total health, not just healing. God wants you continually in a state of good health. Sickness is not part of redemption. 3 John 1:2, Luke 13:13, 16

The price for your total health has been fully paid; Jesus paid with His blood for You and I.

Redemption has re positioned us above all principalities and power that afflict and torment us.

What Is In the Communion that Heals?

The communion is the combination of the blood and the flesh of Christ.

Matthew 26:26-28, Hebrews 2:11

What is In the Blood?

1. There is no illness in the blood of Jesus, so when you take it in via the communion, you take on His nature. Leviticus 17:11, John 6:57
2. The communion rescues us from the powers of darkness waring against our health and wellbeing. Revelations 12:11
3. The blood defends our body against the assault of the wicked. Exodus 12:3-5/12

What is In the Flesh?

1. The bread in the communion is the symbol of the rod of God that swallowed up the rods of the Egyptians. Matthew 26:26 / Exodus 7:11

2. A miracle meal that neutralizes all kinds of poison. 2 Kings 4:39-40
3. It's the new testament Manna which holds greater value than the one eaten in the wilderness. John 6:57-58, Psalm 105:37
4. Empowers us into new realms of revelation. Luke 24:30-31, Isaiah 60:1-3, Job 33:21-25

Every time you study the Word, plead the blood over your mind Or partake of the communion for insight to flow.
